Is this program right for you? Ask yourself.....

- In order to be considered for the program, candidates must answer YES to ALL of the above questions.

FMDP Recruitment Process

- ➢ We recruit for this program once a year in September and extend offers in October. We onboard twice a year (January & July)
- First round interviews are conducted on campus at local schools or via telephone. Second round interviews are held in Toronto in mid October.
- Candidates are invited to submit applications online at <u>www.rbc.com/careers</u> in the fall, when the posting is live. We do not accept applications or resumes via email.
- Our goal is to recruit six people annually. We normally receive approximately 300 400 applications.
- Candidates are encouraged to differentiate themselves and standout amongst their peers. They are encouraged to profile their transferrable skills. We value fluency with a second language; international education; international work experience; finance accreditations (CFA, CMA, CA); community involvement. We are looking for talented graduates that know they want a career in finance, that are focused on becoming finance specialists in Toronto.
