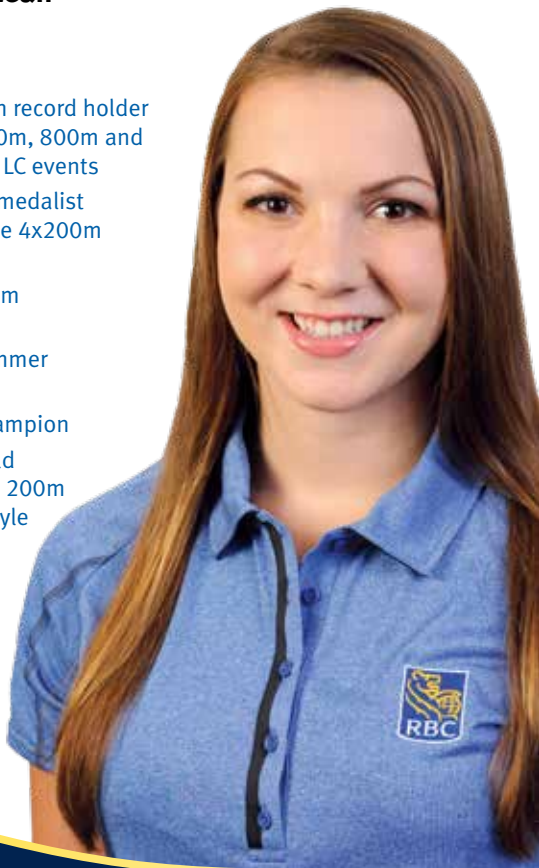


Brittany MacLean

Brittany is an Olympic swimmer who had the honour of representing Canada at the London 2012 and Rio 2016 Olympic Games. As a family-oriented person, she couldn't have been happier to have her older sister and inspiration, Heather, competing in London by her side. While attending the University of Georgia, Brittany was the 2014 NCAA Swimmer of the Year and has won three NCAA team titles over her four years. Her career was highlighted in Rio with an Olympic bronze medal in the 4x200m freestyle relay, and she is the current Canadian record holder in the 200m, 400m, 800m and 1500m freestyle events. Brittany has now retired from competition but remains an avid fan of Canadian athletics. After graduating with a degree in Sport Management, she hopes to give back and make an impact on other athletes, allowing sport to remain a part of her life forever.

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
