# Colin Mathieson, RBC Olympian

In 1989, Colin was encouraged by his family to explore wheelchair racing after being inspired by both Rick Hansen's Man in Motion Tour and the Manitoba Marathon athletes. After a short but successful junior career, he qualified at age 15 for a Canadian Senior National Team event in 1995. Colin competed in his first Paralympic Games in 1996, earning a bronze medal in the 4x400m. Over the past 19 years Colin has amassed 19 Canadian Championship titles, 4 World Championship medals and 1 European Championship title. In addition to his sport accomplishments, he is also in the process of completing his Bachelor of Social Work degree and hopes to someday work in a sport capacity using both his education and athletics experience.
