





## Marie-Phillip Poulin, RBC Olympian

Marie-Philip is known as one of the greatest clutch performers in hockey history. In the Gold Medal game at the 2014 Sochi Olympic Games she scored the gametving goal with just 55 seconds remaining in regulation time, and then the game-winner in overtime, to defeat the U.S.A. Incredibly, four years earlier at the Vancouver Olympic Games, Marie scored both goals as Canada defeated the Americans 2-0 to win Gold. She has been with the national team program since 2007 and has won many medals with Canada in international competitions. Marie-Philip recently graduated from Boston University with a Degree in psychology, and was nominated twice for the Patty Kazmaier Award as the top female player in NCAA hockey. Since graduating, Marie-Philip has returned home to play for the Canadiennes in the CWHL as she prepares for another shot at Gold at the next Olympic Winter Games in South Korea.
