Marie-Phillip Poulin, RBC Olympian

Marie-Philip is known as one of the greatest clutch performers in hockey history. In the Gold Medal game at the 2014 Sochi Olympic Games she scored the game-tying goal with just 55 seconds remaining in regulation time, and then the game-winner in overtime, to defeat the U.S.A. Incredibly, four years earlier at the Vancouver Olympic Games, Marie scored both goals as Canada defeated the Americans 2-0 to win Gold. She has been with the national team program since 2007 and has won many medals with Canada in international competitions. Marie-Philip recently graduated from Boston University with a Degree in psychology, and was nominated twice for the Patty Kazmaier Award as the top female player in NCAA hockey. Since graduating, Marie-Philip has returned home to play for the Canadiennes in the CWHL as she prepares for another shot at Gold at the next Olympic Winter Games in South Korea.
