Michael Tayler burst onto the Senior International scene when he claimed Canada's lone Canoe/Kayak Slalom spot for London 2012. He went on to finish 20th in the men's K-1 event. At just 20 years old, he was the youngest competitor in the field. He secured his second Olympic team nomination for Rio 2016 in large part thanks to his victories in all four K-1 runs at the 2016 national trials. At Rio 2016, Tayler missed advancing to the semifinal by one spot, placing 16th. In addition to sport, Michael also graduated from Carleton University in June 2016 with a degree in law and history and was also a member of Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity at Carleton.
