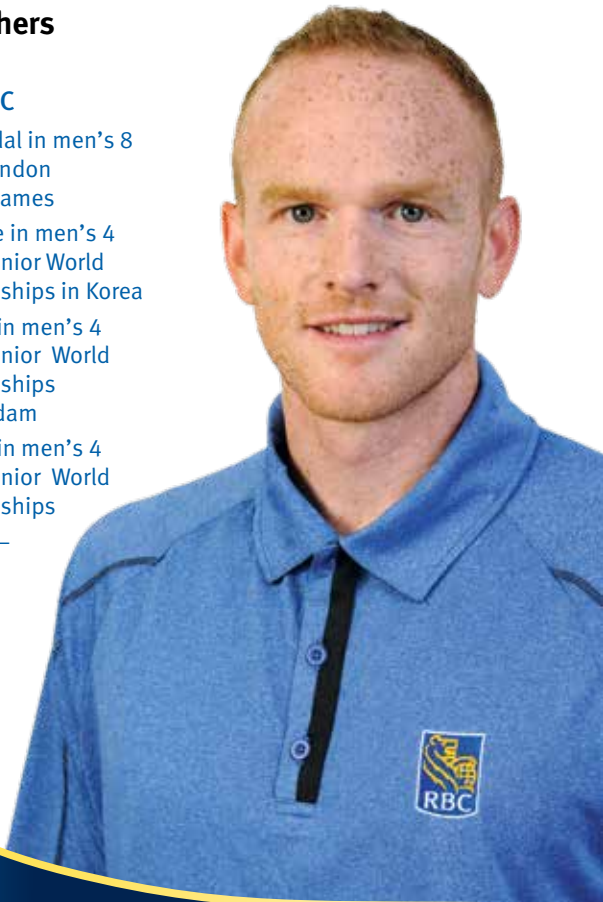


Will Crothers

Will started his rowing career in Kingston, Ontario at KCVI high school, where he first fell in love with the sport. He had some amazing coaches and peers who pointed him in the direction of the Olympic Games. With the Olympic fire lit inside him, he soon achieved enough results to gain the attention of some major rowing schools in the U.S. Will attended the University of Washington, where he was surrounded by some excellent coaches and athletes. At the end of his four years, with the help of the coaching staff and his teammates, he had collected a Bachelor's degree in Geography and a few national titles for his school. In 2010 school was over and he moved back to Canada for the final push towards the London Olympic Games. In London he stroked the men's 8 to a silver medal and completed his journey to his first Olympic Games. Will decided to spend another four years chasing the elusive Olympic gold in Rio in 2016 and was able to make it to the A final with a sixth place finish.
