




Effects of Rising Gas and Food Prices on Budget




Personal Debt (Averages)






Managing Debt






Personal Finances Over the Next Year

Delaying Vacation Plans Until Next Year





How will higher gas prices affect how you choose your next vehicle? B.4



(Canadian economy).


Thinking about the next year or so, do you, yourself, generally feel that the Canadian economy and your own economic situation will improve, stay the same or get worse? Q.9_1.

Outlook for Personal Financial Situation - Over the Next Year Total National: Improve = 39% (same), Worsen = 20% (-2)


