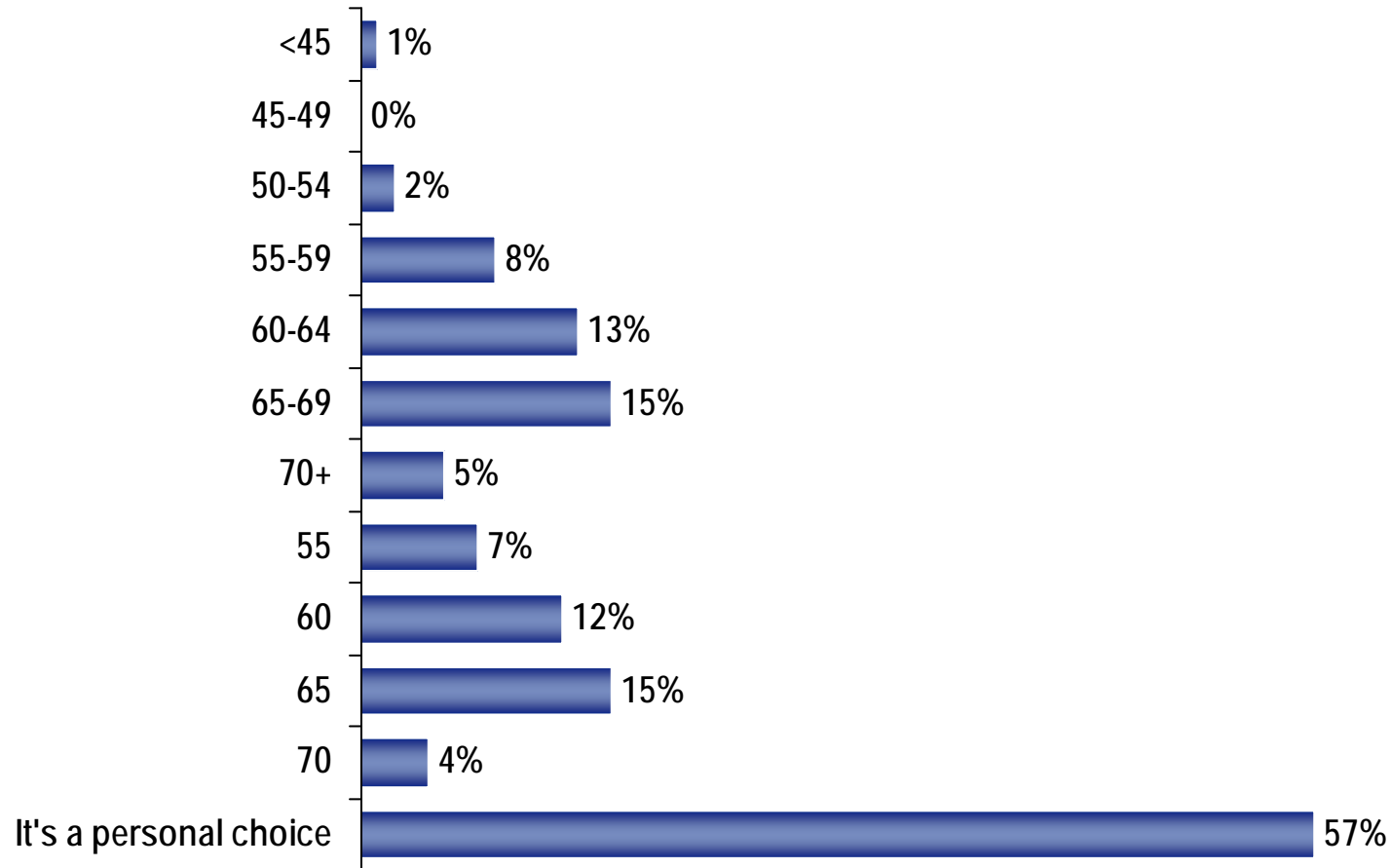




More than half of Canadians feel there is no one appropriate age for retirement and that it is a personal choice

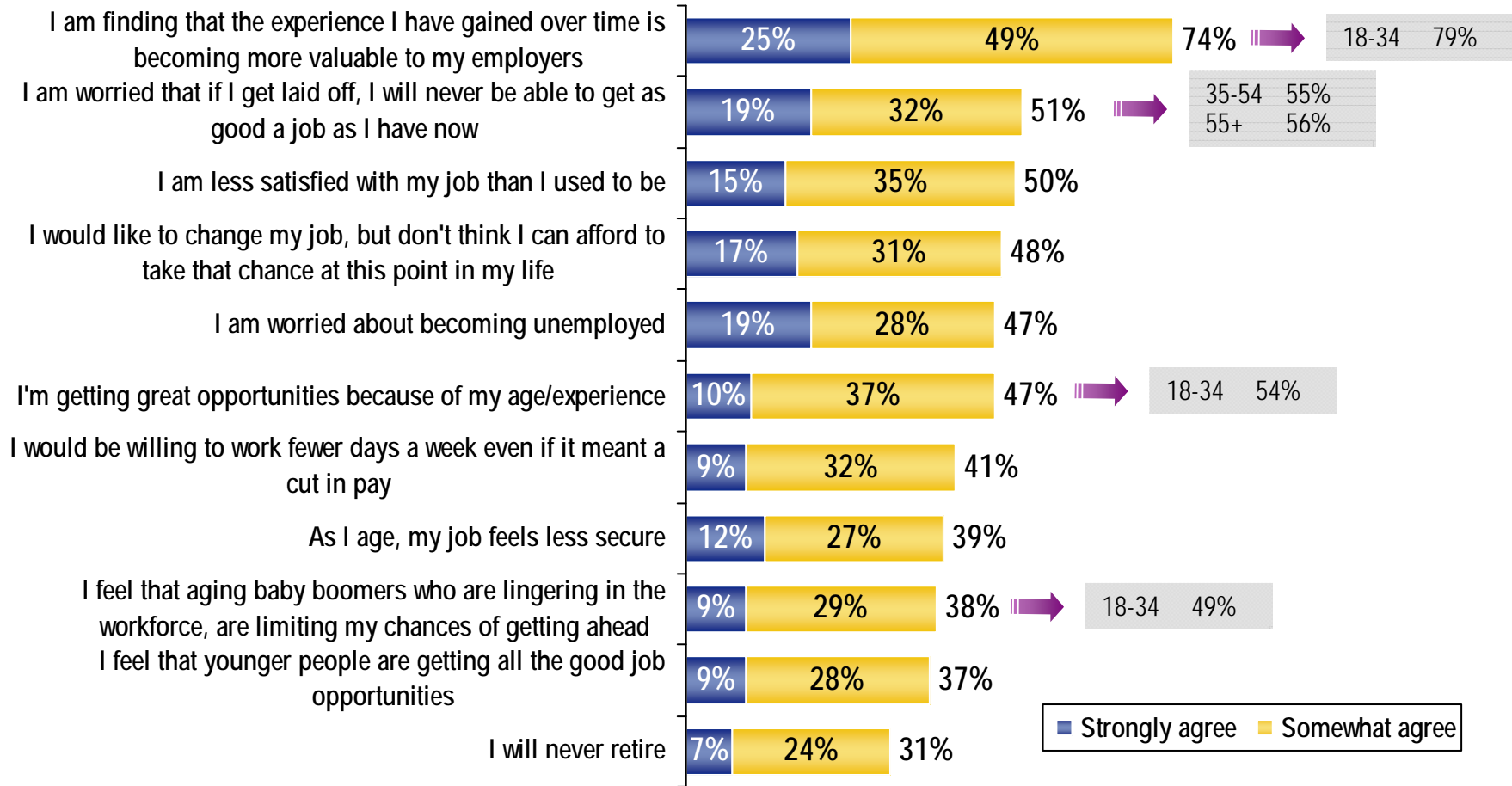


QJ1 What do you think is the appropriate age for people to retire?

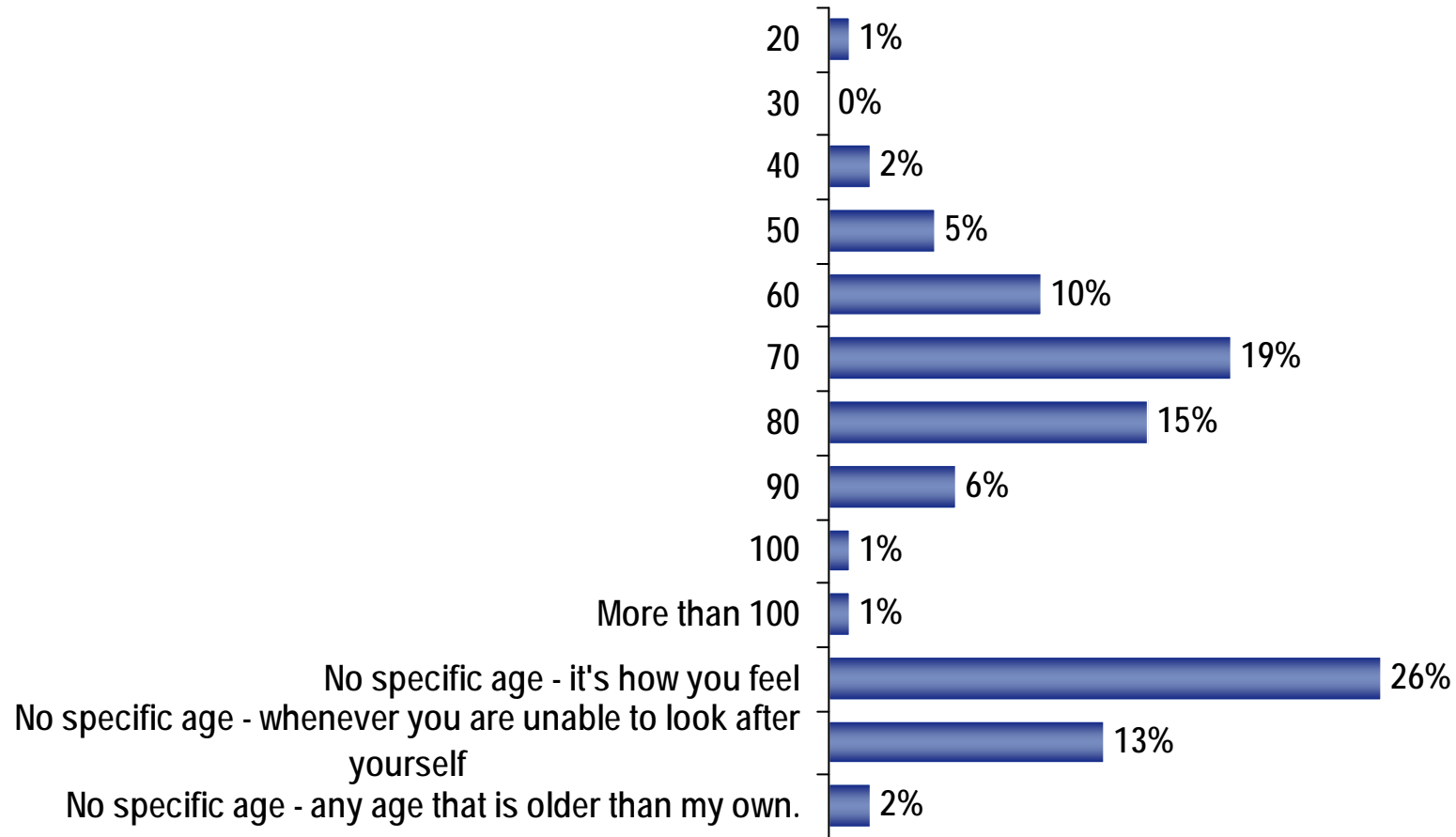

'Old' is 70 or older - or how you feel



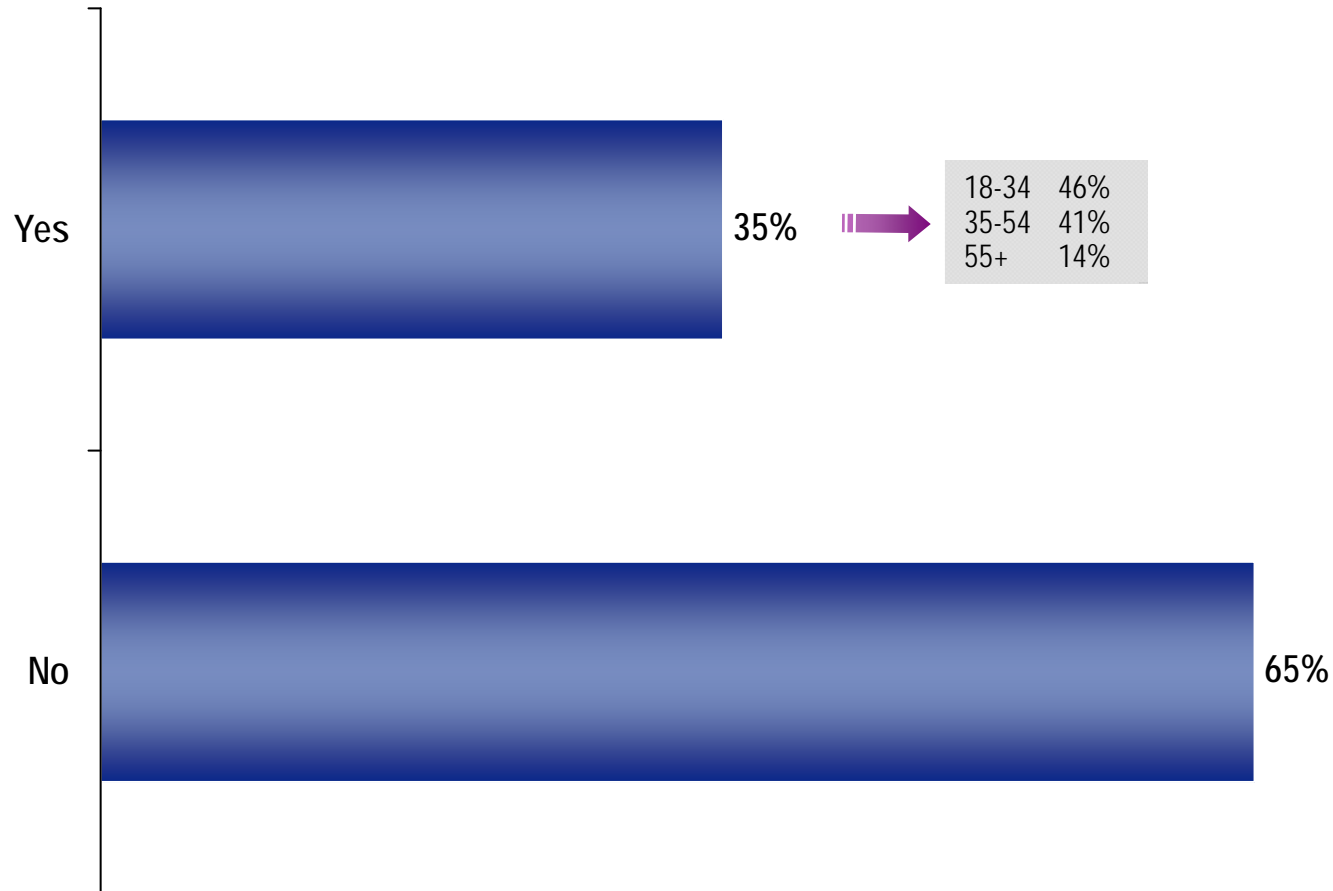
Q.F2 Different people have different ideas about aging. In your opinion, what age is 'old'?

1-in-3 Canadians feel that the aging population of Canada will be a financial burden. Those who are 55 or older are unlikely to feel this.

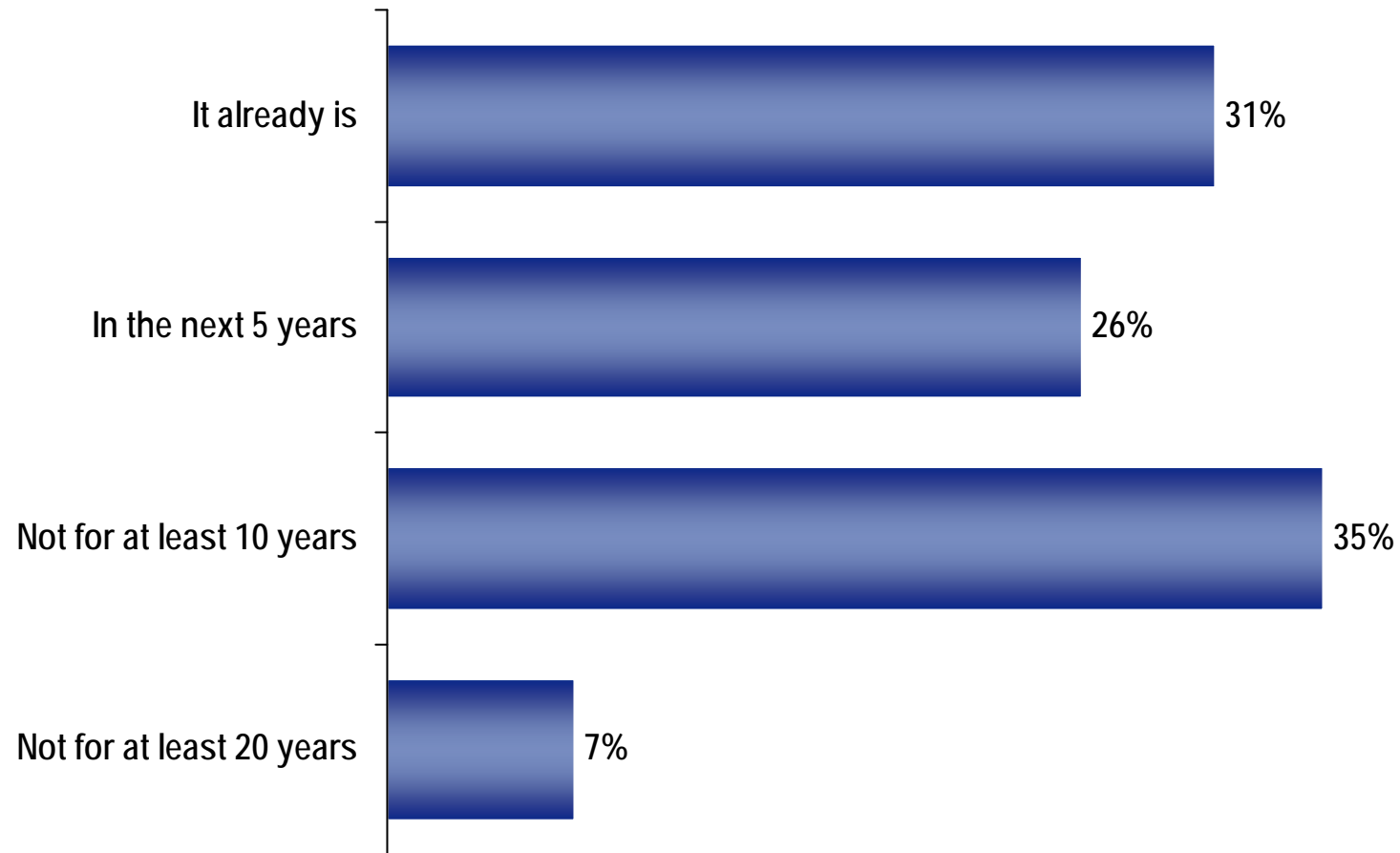


Q.F3 Do you think that the aging population of Canada will be a financial burden to you?
