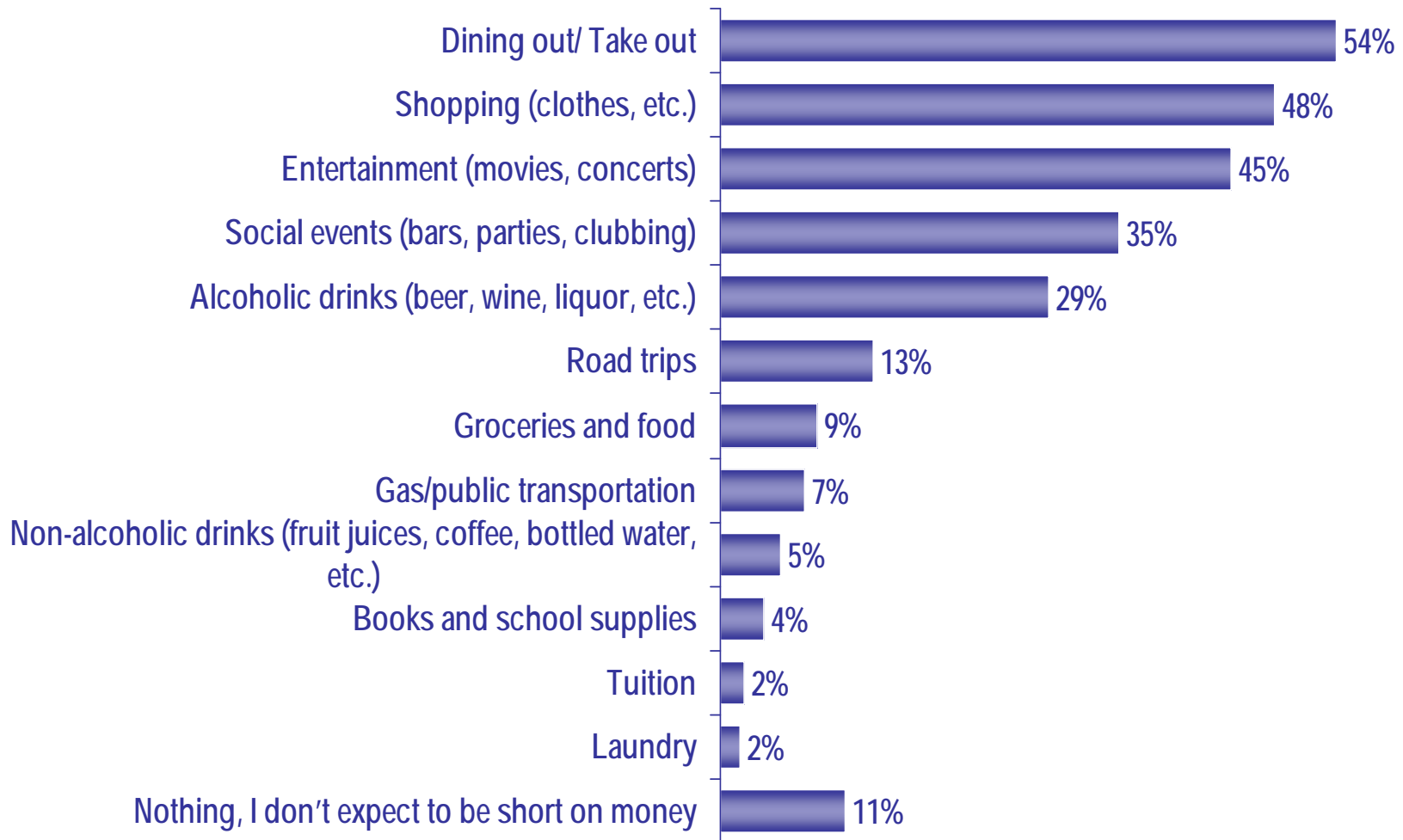




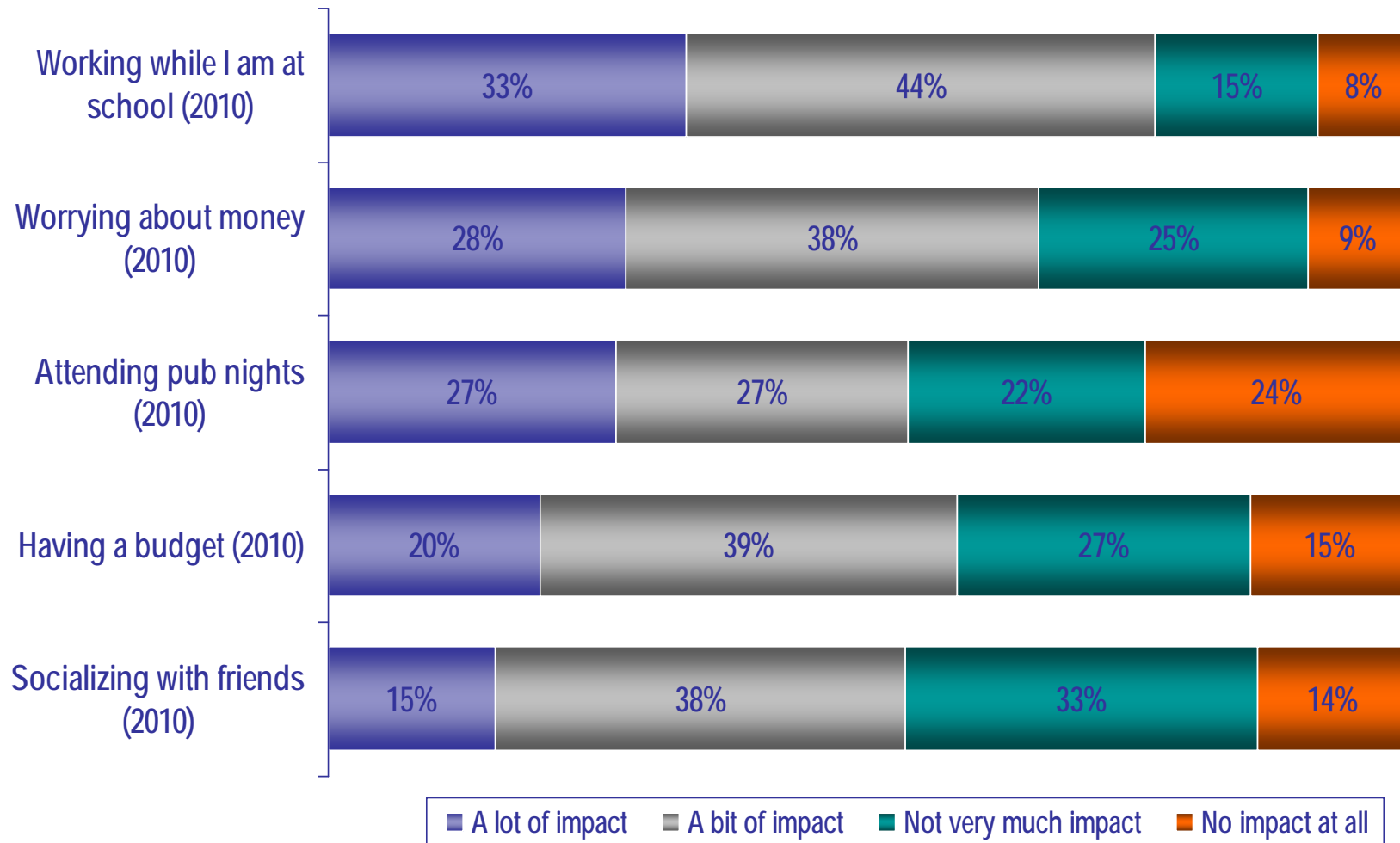
Eating out, shopping and entertainment are most commonly named as the top three items to be cut back on if money is tight; just one-in-ten students don't expect to have to cut back at all

Base: All respondents (n=531)



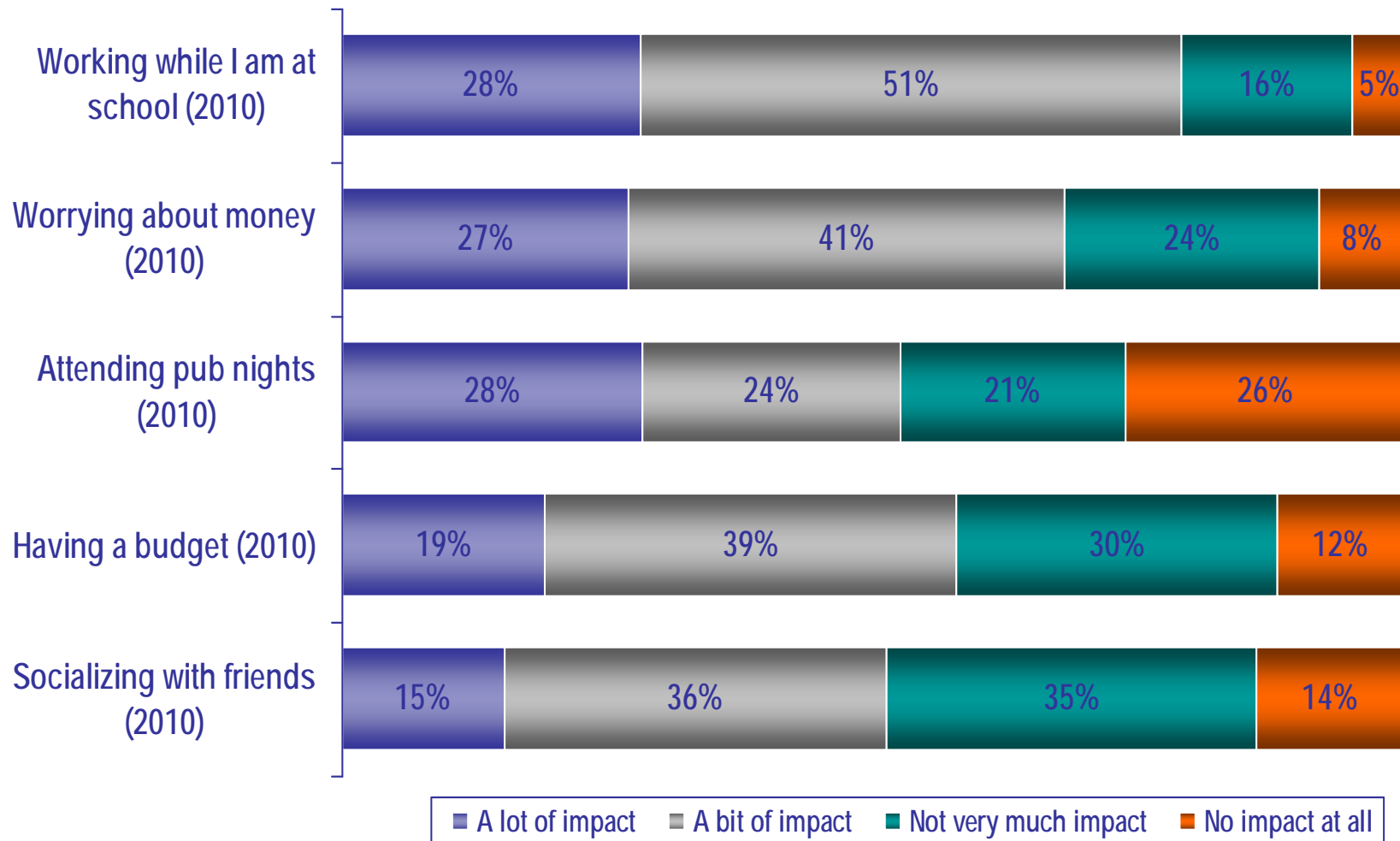
Three-quarters expect that working while at school will have some impact on grades; two-thirds feel that worrying about money will have an impact on their grades

Base: All respondents (n=531)



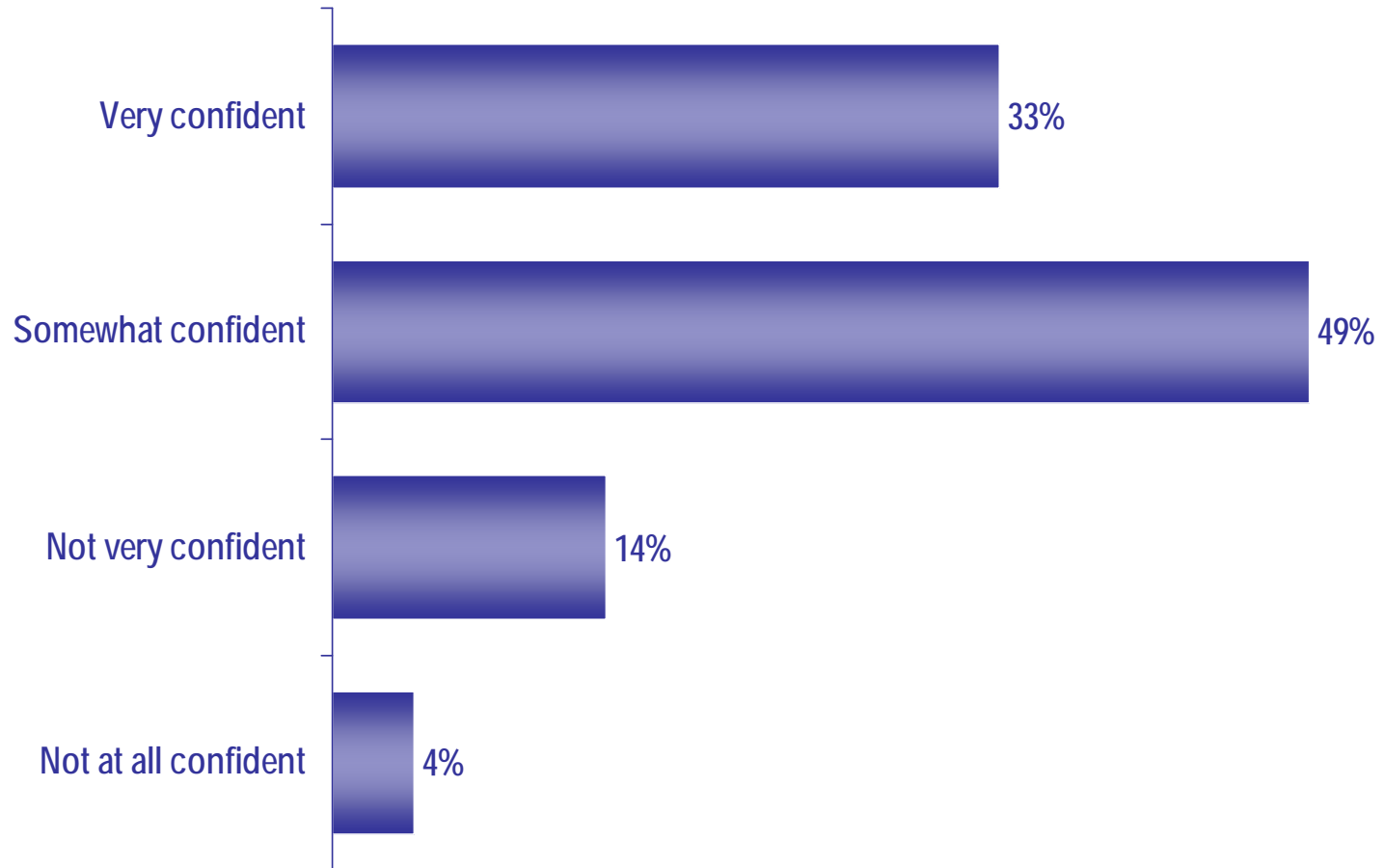
Among those who expect to work part-time, 8-in-10 believe that working has some impact on grades; 3-in-10 believe it will have a lot of impact

Base: Respondents who expect to work part time (n=300)



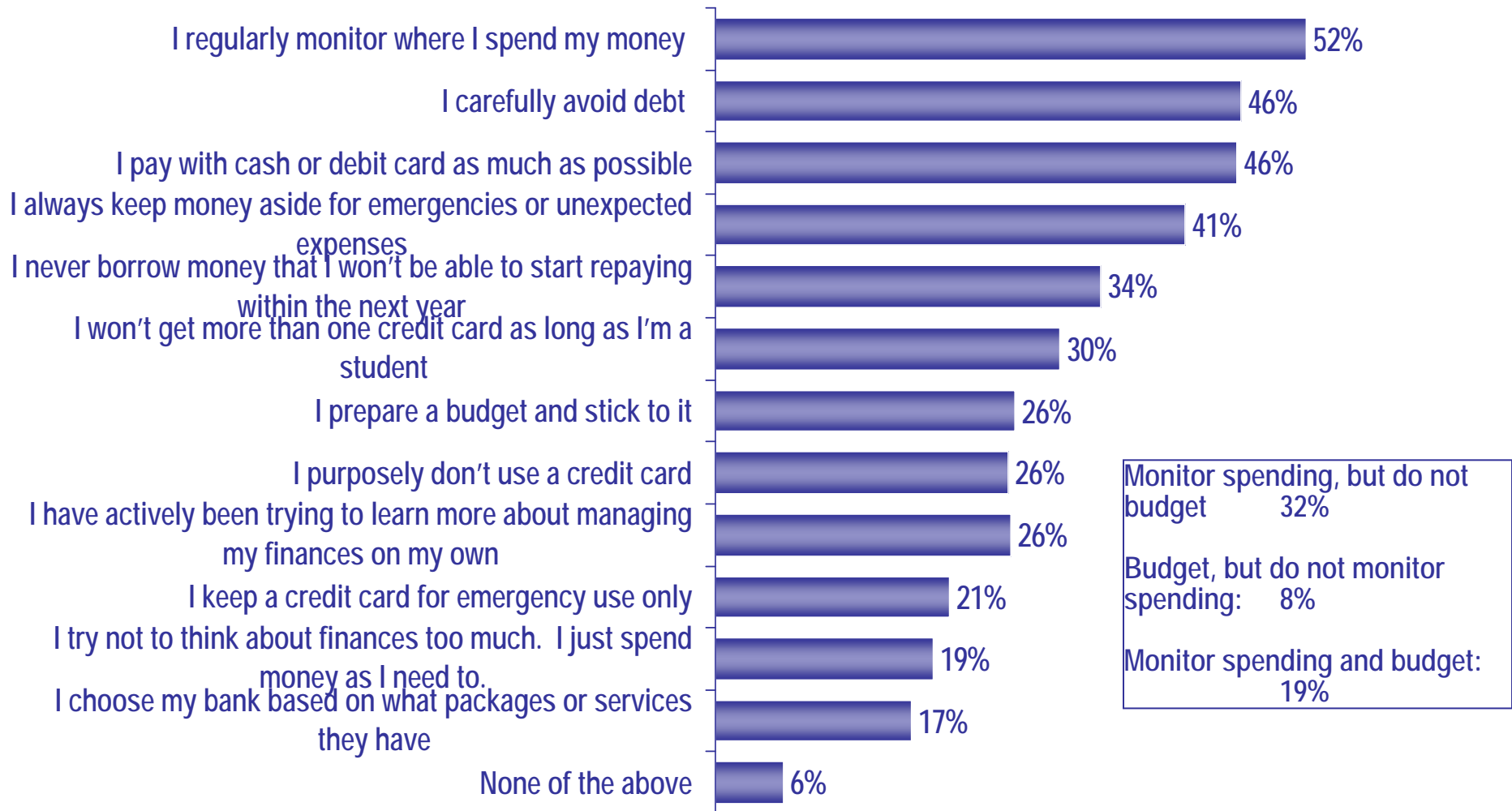
Just one-third are very confident that they know what level of debt they will have when they graduate
