



RBC CANADIAN OPEN MILLION DOLLAR SHOOTOUT PUTTING GREEN FUN FACTS

- Built on a fully ballasted 40 x 150 ft. barge
 - Regulation sized floating golf green
 - Authentic USGA approved turf
 - 198 sheets of plywood
 - Approximately 18 Fuji steel stanchions welded 6'-8' from the hull
 - Reinforced side walls
 - Approximately 350 yards of sand (455 tonnes)
 - Green consists of approximately 4100 sq. ft. of USGA approved bentgrass
 - Rough consists of approximately 2200 sq. ft. of No. 1 Kentucky Bluegrass
 - Three bunkers topped with California Baja sand
 - Full skirting of barge
 - Two pin placements - 165 yards & 175 yards
 - Fully contained automatic sprinkler system
 - Green sits approximately 4.5 ft. above water line with a six degree slope toward the tee box
 - Barge's floating location is fixed (leading edge sits approximately 140 yards off of Polson Pier)
 - Approximately 600 man hours required for the build alone
 - All golf balls used for the RBC Million Dollar Shootout will be two-piece low density solid center floating golf balls. This will eliminate any environmental impact on the Toronto Harbour.
