BC Medical Services Plan

The BC MSP premiums and the Regular Premium Assistance program are changing effective Jan. 1, 2017. MSP premiums will no longer be charged for children under the age of 19 years. MSP premium rates will be determined by the number of adults on an MSP account. This can be one or two people: the MSP account holder and a spouse, if applicable.
