

How to attend and vote at the annual meeting of common shareholders



April 9, 2026

The annual meeting of common shareholders will take place both online and in person.

Only registered shareholders and duly appointed proxyholders (including non-registered (beneficial) shareholders who have appointed themselves as proxyholders) who have presented valid government-issued photo identification at the registration desk will be granted access to the in-person meeting. Non-shareholders and non-registered (beneficial) owners who have not duly appointed themselves as proxyholders will be able to attend the meeting online as guests.

Dial-in information

Registered shareholders, non-registered (beneficial) shareholders and guests can attend the meeting via telephone. Those attending via telephone will not be able to vote or participate at the meeting.

Voting at the meeting

Only registered shareholders and duly appointed proxyholders are entitled to submit their votes at the meeting either in person or online.

Non-registered (beneficial) shareholders may not participate in the vote at the meeting unless they have appointed themselves or a person to represent them as a proxyholder and have also registered with Computershare.

The chair of the meeting will indicate the time of opening and closure of voting. If attending online, the voting options will be visible on your screen or, if attending in person, via the handheld device or paper ballot provided at the registration desk.

If attending online, it is important that you are connected to the internet at all times during the meeting in order to vote when voting commences. Please ensure that your internet connection is adequate throughout the meeting.
